Is there a particular couple you admire? For us it is Randy and Patty Kington, our friends in Naples, Florida.

As an enlisted man of 18, Randy served on the front line with some of the first Marine combat units in Vietnam. On March 21, 1966, during one of the most intense three hours of the Vietnam war, Randy received a horrific wound that resulted in him becoming a paraplegic. From that point on he would never walk again and would be confined to a wheelchair the rest of his life.

During one of his stays in a hospital, Patty who was 17, came to the hospital with her Aunt and Uncle who were leaders in the DAV to give the "boys" a Christmas party. Randy couldn't attend the party because he had recently had surgery. So Patty went to see him. They spent two hours together that day. After Randy was released from that hospital, he and Patty spent every possible moment together. After a few dates she

agreed to marry Randy even after he explained all the problems they would be facing.

Patty's mom refused to meet Randy and didn't want Patty to ever see him again. She wanted more for her daughter than to marry some old veteran (he was probably 19 or 20 at the time) who was disabled. So Patty and Randy eloped. In time, Patty's parents came to accept and love Randy. Patty was a brilliant young lady and had planned on going into the medical field, but instead devoted her life to taking care of Randy.

After retiring from the Marine Corp, Randy earned a B.S., Master of Accounting and became a CPA. He taught college and eventually owned his own CPA firm. And he gives so much credit to Patty who helped make this happen.

They have two grown sons and three grandchildren. Randy and Patty have been married now 52 years. Patty tells us the years have flown by and some of the days and years have been awesome and some have been awful. She goes on to say, "We have been through so much words can barely describe all the joy, laughter, pain and tears. But I wouldn't take anything for it."

Randy has written a book called What a Life - How the Vietnam War Affected One Marine." We'd love for you to read it. It is not only about his experience as a Marine, he and Patty's love story but about our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and how He has worked in the Kington's lives.

"Husband and wives: Are you investing more in your jobs than in

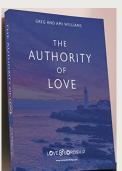
