<u>Are Your Thoughts Sabotaging Your Relationship?</u>

Do you focus more on what's going wrong than right? Do you play "what if's' in your mind? Or do you have suspicious thoughts that keep popping up?

It is recommended you start paying attention to your thoughts. Write them down whenever you have a negative feeling. Could the story you are telling be creating that negativity? If so record how your behavior was affected by that feeling. One person said it helped her to see that nothing was just happening to her - her thinking was at the root of what she was experiencing in her relationship. She went on to say that if thoughts were the only problem - that problem was in her control. Our thoughts run a fine line between observing our reality and creating it.

The Lord tells in Philippians 4:8 "Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable — if anything is excellent or praiseworthy — think about such things."


According to Harley, here are the top ten needs and the activity Greg graciously shared with us. It is available by clicking here.
