Why Does My Wife Expect Me to Read Her Mind?

Shaunti Feldhahn, social researcher, best-selling author and popular speaker, said she has identified four crucial truths that will help men understand this.

- She has a vulnerability inside that you may not be aware of. Your wife or girlfriend doesn't actually expect you to read her mind. However, she does expect you to notice when something is wrong and press into it. She wants you to pay attention to her, to find out what she's thinking, what matters to her, what is going on in her heart.
- When you seek out what matters to her, without being told, you are signaling how much you love her.
- When you routinely seek out what matters to her, and "learn" her every day it will build a true security under the surface of her heart.
- Seeking out what matters to her emotionally, is just as important as providing for the family financially.


